**Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...**

- ➔ Sharpen strategic processes, with a focus on collaboratively identifying strategies, targets, timelines and success measures, along with approaches from the framework of 'Clarity', that support the achievement of targets in English.
- ➔ Strengthen the instructional leadership capability of all members of the leadership team, and emerging leaders, to lead systematic and deliberate approaches for driving an explicit improvement agenda.
- ➔ Develop the curriculum capability of all teaching staff including key leaders to confidently engage with curriculum design and quality assurance processes.
- ➔ Collaboratively embed the school's inclusion framework that builds a mindset of staff for Inclusive Education (IE) and identifies consistent and transparent systems and processes, and prioritises actions and accountabilities.
- ➔ Build capability of staff and the IE team to meet the diverse learning needs of all students, including those with complex case needs, and to provide expertise within year level teams.
